

Indian Valley Elementary School Expectations for Traditional, Blended, & Virtual Students

The Sylacauga City School System has incorporated an alternating schedule that will follow the outline below:

Group A: Student's last name ends in A-L.

Group B: Student's last name ends in M-Z.

Siblings with different last names may be accommodated on alternating days so that the family members will attend school on the same days.

[raditional Students

- The traditional student will receive in-person instruction on his or her designated
- On the days not in school, the student will receive resources to practice skills while at home.
- A chromebook is not needed for the days not in school.
- Parents can utilize digital resources, however, it is not required.
- Teachers will make contact throughout the week on the days students are not in school to ensure clarity on the resource materials provided.

- The blended student will receive instruction virtually.
- The blended student will meet with his or her blended teacher Monday Friday.
- The blended student will have required times to be on a Google Meet with their teacher. The required times are during school hours. (Times will be provided at a later date)
- The blended student is not expected to be logged into the computer all day.
- Expectations are set by the blended teacher.
- Blended students are expected to come to campus to take summative assessments, benchmark assessments, state assessments, and any other assessments needed for data purposes.
- Virtual Learning Agreement must be completed before participation in this option.
- The virtual student will receive instruction virtually.
- Virtual students will be provided independent assignments to work on throughout the week.
- Virtual teachers are available Monday through Friday 3:00 pm -7:00 pm via phone, email, or any other digital form of communication.
- Students are expected to work independently on assignments.
- Virtual students are expected to come to campus to take summative assessments, benchmark assessments, state assessments, and any other assessments needed for data purposes.
- Virtual Learning Agreement must be completed before participation in this option.
