<p>Teachers and staff would like to welcome all traditional students back to a four day learning week. We are excited to have this opportunity to see each student. Thank you for trusting us with your child during this uncertain time. Please know, IVES will do whatever it takes to ensure the safety and well being of all students.</p>	<p>All traditional students will participate in a four day school day. All traditional students will participate in In-Person learning on <b>Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday.</b> Cleaning and disinfecting will be on Wednesday. Students will not go to school on Wednesday.</p>	<p>At this time, there will be no visitors allowed in the building. Someone will assist visitors at the entrance of the school.</p>	<p><b>Arrival:</b> Students may begin being dropped off between 7:20 am-7:40 am. <b>Kindergarten-Second Grade</b> students are dropped off in the back of the school off of Motes Road. <b>Pre-K students ONLY</b> are dropped off in the front of the school off of Oldfield Road. Students are tardy at 7:45 am.</p> <p><b>Dismissal:</b> Students may begin getting picked up in the back of the school, off of Motes Road, beginning at 2:45 pm. Individuals picking up car riders must show the car rider decal assigned to the student. If there is no decal, the driver must pull to the front of the school and be verified by a staff member. A license is needed for verification. Car riders not picked up by 3:00 pm will be walked to the office and the parent/guardian will be called.</p> <p>Please remember not to pass anyone in the car rider line during arrival or dismissal times.</p>
