Blended (Option B) and Virtual (Option C) Learners**

<p>Curriculum and Instruction</p>	<p>Blended-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The curriculum will utilize a variety of online programs and materials that will be accessed by using Google classroom. ● All blended students will have opportunities for virtual instruction from a teacher at Pinecrest. ● Blended students are expected to log on to Google Meet/Zoom at set times during the week to participate in instruction. ● Content will be released to students on Monday morning and students will have until the following Sunday night to complete the classwork. <p>Virtual-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The curriculum is fully online and accessed via its own platform. No instruction is provided by a teacher. ● All virtual students should complete the online curriculum at the pace provided by the pacing guide. ● Virtual students are expected to log on to Google Meet/Zoom at set times during the week to check in with his or her teacher. ● Content is available 24/7 and may be completed at the student's own pace.
<p>Addressing a Learner's Specific Instructional Needs</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students will have access to Learning Ally, Stride Academy and other online resources to supplement instruction. ● Students with specific learning plans (IEP, I-ELP, GEP, 504) will receive services, modifications, and accommodations written into the plan in order for the district to provide a free and appropriate public education. Parents are encouraged to give input regarding their child's learning needs.
