

NLMS 7th & 8th Grade Dance 2021

The Student Council Dance will be on **Friday, Jan 21st from 7-9pm**. Only 7th and 8th grade NLMS students may attend the dance. It is an informal middle school dance designed to provide a fun, safe, social activity for our students. The following is important information regarding the dance:

- Any student who has been assigned ISS and/or corporal punishment for more than two occurrences.
- Any student who has been assigned OSS or alternative placement during the school year will not be allowed to attend. Discipline records will be checked to ensure only those who qualify (per above criteria) attend the dance.
- Students from other schools may not attend/participate.
- **Students will NOT be allowed to check in or out the day of the dance for any dance-related activities.**
- Girls ARE NOT allowed to wear strapless dresses or dresses that are too revealing in the front or the back. Clear straps are permitted. No two-piece dresses. Party dresses and/or Sunday dresses are allowed. Dresses should not be shorter than three inches above the knee. Jumpsuits and/or Dress Pants and Dress Tops may also be worn.
- Boys ARE REQUIRED to wear a tie, collared shirt, and dress pants to the dance. Any boy coming to the dance without a tie will be asked to leave.
- Any student seen dancing inappropriately will be given one warning. If warned a second time, parents will be called to come and pick them up from the dance. Inappropriate dancing is based on the judgment of the faculty and chaperones. There is NO appeal.
- Students are responsible for whatever they bring to the dance. Neither NLMS nor the Student Council are responsible for lost/stolen items.
- **Admission to the dance will be sold in advance for \$20.00 per person. Students will turn money (exact cash) and permission forms into their Homeroom teachers on any of the following dates: January 11, 12, 18, or 19.** Money and permission forms must be turned in together and will NOT be accepted after January 19th. Payment at the door will NOT be accepted.
- The dance will begin at 7:00 PM and end promptly at 9:00 PM. Students will be allowed to enter the dance at 7:00 PM (no sooner). Students must be picked up NO LATER than 9:15 PM.
- Students will check in at the attendance table upon entering the school the night of the dance. Students do not receive a ticket. Instead, there is a list of names at the check-in table of those who have paid and turned in the permission form. **Only those whose names are on the check-in list may enter the dance.**
- Students will need to bring money (exact cash) for pictures the night of the dance. Professional pictures will be taken at the dance. Picture information will be given out the week of the dance. (Information will be on the school website.)
- Parents are invited to enter the dance for the first 30 minutes to take pictures but will be asked to leave after 30 minutes have passed.
- Parents should be in the car rider line at/or before 9:00 to pick the students up. No parent should park in the car rider line to enter the building. If you must enter the building, please park in the parking lot, NOT in the car rider line. At 9:00 students will exit to the car rider line.
